SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.408 dated 15.07.2015, under Sections 333, 353, 186, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that on 14.07.2015, complainant was driving bus No.HR-38-S-1216. At about 6:00 PM, when the bus reached near village Banchari, a WagonR Car bearing No.HR-28-D-5286 came from behind and struck the bus by stopping the Car in front of the bus. Thereafter, driver of the Car started abusing and inflicting injuries on the person of Satpal conductor of the bus. When the complainant tried to intervene, 2-3 other persons also came out from the Car and started inflicting injuries on the person of the complainant and Satpal with rod, *lathi* and

danda. When they raised alarm, a Haryana Roadways bus coming from behind stopped and driver of the bus tried to save the complainant and Satpal but he was also inflicted injuries by the accused. Thereafter, accused left the spot after giving threats.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely involved in this case.

Allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. Petitioner and his co-accused had attacked the complainant and his co-employee and driver of the Haryana Roadways bus. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the seriousness of allegations levelled against the petitioner, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
