This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.157 dated 08.06.2015 under Section 406 IPC, at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since August 27, 2015 and case is triable by Magistrate. Besides, a compromise has also been effected between the parties.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

However, keeping in view the fact that it is a magisterial trial, which is likely to take some time to conclude, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.
