Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Parwinder Kaur in case FIR No.4 dated 09.01.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and Section 24 of the Immigration Act registered with Police Station Balongi, SAS Nagar, Mohali, District Mohali.

As per allegations of the complainant, petitioner-accused along with her husband Dilbagh Singh had received a sum of Rs.2 lacs out of the demand of Rs.5 lacs for sending son of the complainant abroad. It was stated that the husband of the petitioner namely Dilbagh Singh was arrested and after three months of custody was granted regular bail.

The allegations against the present petitioner is that she had

received the amount from Dilbagh Singh and as such no offence is made out.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Charanjit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 09th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
