ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 59 dated 08.06.2013, registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 384, 177, 506, 120-B IPC, Police Station Naya Gaon, District S.A.S. Nagra (Mohali).

It is necessary to refer to the facts. Jasjit Khurana is a resident of Canada. He had lodged a complaint with the police. He owns a plot in village Kansal, District Mohali. The allegations are that Munish Gupta approached him through his contact but later in a fraudulent manner got his plot transferred. Munish then entered into an agreement with Jaspal and also with Gopal Krishan. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was also involved in the conspiracy. He is the son of Jaspal Singh and a witness in both the agreements.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is merely a witness to the agreement to sell and he is not accused of cheating. He further contends that Munish and Jaspal had been arrested.

The State counsel opposes the bail application and urges that recovery is to be effected and the petitioner alleges that the agreement entered with his father had been cancelled and all the facts would only appear on interrogation.

The case is at the investigation stage. No fetters can be placed upon the Investigators. The plot is owned by a Non Resident Indian which has been fraudulently transferred. The petitioner is a witness to the successive agreements. His father is said to have entered into the agreement. It is also his case that the agreement was subsequently cancelled but no document was filed. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
