Petitioner is in custody in the present case on the allegation that 200 grams of intoxicant powder containing alprazolam was recovered from his house while investigation in a case of extortion in FIR No.182 dated 01.06.2014 was being conducted.

The petitioner remained on interim bail during the period when the report of Chemical Examiner was awaited. Whether the recovery of the intoxicant powder from the house of petitioner which is accessible to others, could be deemed to be

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from the exclusive possession of the petitioner, would be a debatable issue during the course of trial.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.
