Petitioner absented on November 7, 2013 in proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act resulting in cancellation of his bail.

A perusal of the order passed by the Sessions Judge, Patiala, indicates that the approach of the petitioner has been casual. He had been evading appearance.

In the interest of expeditious disposal of this case, it is ordered that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court within 15 days from today and will deposit a sum of Rs.7500/- as cost payable to the complainant

for the unnecessary harassment and delay caused, which will be under provisions of Section 309 Explanation 2 Cr.P.C. In case of petitioner's doing so, he will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will continue to appear before the trial Court and will not absent himself without any sufficient cause.

Disposed of.

The order has been passed in limine to save the expenses and harassment to the complainant.
