Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners claim themselves to be rightful owner by virtue of sale deed dated 25.01.2013 executed by one Dewan Chand general power of attorney of his sons. Civil litigation ultimately culminated in favour of vendors and that has become final. On 27.11.2014 care taker of the property in question informed the petitioners that antisocial elements/miscreants have demolished the boundary wall and accordingly the matter was reported to the police. Same thing was repeated on 28.11.2014 also by the miscreants. Respondents No.5 and 6 were allegedly identified to be wrong doers along with others. Inaction on the part of police prompted the petitioners to approach this court. On the aforesaid grievances, representations

and annexure P-5 and P-6 are statedly pending before respondents No.3 and 4 on reference.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 4.

Let four copies of petition be supplied to the State Counsel during the course of the day.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioners and if required necessary protection be provided to them in terms of their life and properties. Respondent No.3 shall also look into the feasibility of transferring the investigation from respondent No.4 to some higher officer in view of apprehension shown by the petitioners after the aforesaid occurrence of demolition. The other grievances of the petitioners shall also be considered by respondent No.3 and if required, necessary action be taken thereafter.

With these observations, petition stands disposed of.
