Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Harkirat Singh @ Sagar in case FIR No.28 dated 12.02.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 394, 382, 341, 323, 427, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54 & 59 of Arms Act registered with Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.

As per allegations the petitioner along with his co-accused Gurmeet Singh and Swaranjit Singh entered the Samsung Showroom on 11.02.2014 at about 7.30 am with muffled faces and on gunpoint are alleged to have stole electronic items and cash to the tune of Rs.6200/-.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused Gurmeet Singh has since been granted bail by this Court vide order at

**Annexure P-3.**

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar admits the custody period as also the bail to the co-accused, however, states that there are three other cases pending against the petitioner. It is further states that out of the 16 witnesses, three witnesses have been examined by the prosecution.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that material witnesses have since been examined and the period of custody, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars. As such the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Fazilka.
