Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.57 dated 6.5.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 120-B , 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station, Goraya, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel has referred to various injuries caused on vital parts of the body of the complainant. In my considered view the nature of injuries is such that instant FIR cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioners to face trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
