Prayer is under section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of direction to the official respondent nos.2 & 3 to register FIR under appropriate sections against the private respondents no.4 to 6 who in connivance with each other had kidnapped the daughter of the petitioner and further to trace out the daughter of the complainant.

Upon notice of the petition detailed reply in the shape of affidavit of DSP Fazilka dated 14.11.2015 has been filed wherein in para no.2 it is stated that Rekha Rani daughter of the petitioner had never been kidnapped rather she went with the respondent no.5-Amandeep Singh on her own. It is further submitted that both of them have performed marriage and had also sought protection from this Court by filing the CRM-M No.23508 of 2015. It is further submitted that during enquiry by the police

daughter of the petitioner was found to be major as per copy of her school certificate showing her date of birth as 05.09.1995 Annexure R-2/T. It was further submitted that both the daughter and respondent no.5-Amandeep Singh are residing as husband and wife and as such no action is required to be taken against the private respondents.

In view of aforesaid reply filed on behalf of the State, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

Dismissed.
