Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.274 dated 21.6.2015, under Section 506 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the ingredients as provided under Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act are not met in the case, however, he prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to approach

the trial Court for regular bail.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for seeking regular bail.

In case the petitioner surrender before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court would consider and decide the application on the same day.
