Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks protection of his life and liberty claiming that respondent No.5 who is working as Head Constable in Amritsar police is bent upon to harass the petitioner and his family members in connection with business of Committee with Gurcharan Singh, respondent No.7, who is related to respondent No.5.

I have considered the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner. Without expression of any opinion on the basis of the apprehensions of the petitioner, I am of the considered opinion that a

representation to the senior police officials would be an appropriate remedy for the petitioner. Annexure P-1 appears to have been filed by the petitioner to SSP (Rural), Amritsar.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jashanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of without expression of any opinion on merits with a direction to the SSP (Rural), Amritsar to consider the averments in representation annexure P-1. In case the averments are found to be false, it will be open to the said officer to file the complaint. However, in case it is found that any police official in the garb of his position is unnecessarily harassing the petitioner, necessary action in accordance with law will be taken. It will be appreciated in case the necessary steps will be taken within a period of three months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order.
