**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.300 dated 14.11.2014 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The allegation was that on 14.11.2014 at about 8 P.M. when the police party was present at the spot they saw motorcycle coming from Patti side and when they were asked to stop the motorcycle stopped, the passenger who is a lady got off but the driver managed to escape on motorcycle on which there was no number plate. The lady was apprehended

and ultimately from her possession 320 gms. of intoxicating powder was recovered. It was she who disclosed that the petitioner was the driver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the whole story is highly incredible.

In my opinion, at this stage the possibility that the story is correct cannot be ruled out. In the circumstances, keeping in view the recovery it cannot be said to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
