Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.57 dated 30.05.2013, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Tamana Sharma alleging that she was married to petitioner No.2 on 09.12.2009 and had been maltreated by petitioner No.2 and his other family members on account of demand of dowry.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Matrimonial dispute having been amicably resolved, I do not find any reason not to quash the proceedings.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
