Report dated 18.09.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Taranjit Puri and Raj Rani Puri as well as of complainant Rupali Sharma it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure matrimonial dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.35 dated 19.05.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station, Phase VIII, Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua
