By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115, dated 08.08.2015, registered under Sections 15 and 25 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states in pursuance of the order dated 07.09.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.09.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
