Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439, Cr.P.C., is for grant of bail to petitioner Shiv Kumar, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 4, 5 and 7 of Immoral Trafficking Prevention Act, in a case arising out of FIR No.244 dated 08.04.2015, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Karnal.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was allegedly arrested on 08.04.2015, when he was found in a compromising position with a prostitute in a room at Hotel Dawat.

He further contends that the petitioner is neither required nor involved in any other case and most of the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted bail.

Learned counsel for the State has not controverted the above argument.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Shiv Kumar, son of Mann Singh, resident of House No.255, Gali No.2, Basant Vihar, Karnal, presently confined in District Jail, Karnal, is directed to be released on bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Area Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
