Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 of IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 65, dated 16.06.2014, registered at Police Station, Singh Bhagwantpur, District-Ropar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Harbans Singh, very fairly states that in compliance of the interim directions issued vide order dated 03.09.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation. It is further contended that all the dowry articles except the jewellery, as referred in the complaint, have been recovered.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no dowry articles in the form of jewellery with the petitioner and the complainant has failed to submit the bills of such dowry articles in support of her claim.

Without commenting upon the merits on the issue of dowry articles, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued vide order dated 03.09.2014 passed by this Court, are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
