This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant
of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.23 dated
23.10.2014 registered under Sections 138/142 of the Negotiable Instruments
Act read with Section 420 IPC pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate
1st Class, Mewat.

On 07.09.2015 the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion.

To come up on 06.10.2015.

In the meantime, let the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 15.09.2015 and on his appearance he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared and has been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent has accepted this fact and he is not in a position to deny this fact.

Learned Assistant Advocate General as well as the learned counsel for respondent No.1 have accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by the trial Court is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
