Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.106 dated 21.06.2014, under Sections 325, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Dhariwal, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Santokh Kaur alleging that petitioners had assaulted the complainant and her son when they had stopped the petitioners from removing the bricks from the street.

Parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur to make statements regarding the compromise. A report has been received after recording the statements of the parties that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal

proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh, within a period of one month from today. The said amount will be sent to All India Pingalwara Charitable Society, Chandigarh Branch, an institution meant for taking care of destitutes.
