Affidavit of Rajbir Singh ASI, Police Station Alewa, District Jind, Haryana filed in the Court is taken on record.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.80 dated 12.04.2014 registered in Police Station Alewa, District Jind for offence punishable under Sections 395, 397 IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that he is in custody since 21.06.2014. The challan has been presented in the Court but conclusion of trial is likely to take its own time. It is further submitted that another case FIR No.422 dated 21.05.2014 registered against the petitioner is pending before the trial Court and he is on bail in the said case. The petitioner is ready to face proceedings without any default.

Counsel for the State has not disputed factual assertions.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the

controversy, bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, he shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
- (ii) he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
