By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.08, dated 15.07.2015, registered under Sections 420, 406, 498-A, 354, 494, 199 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station NRI Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 28.09.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the complainant opposes the bail.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 28.09.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
