Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.40 dated 16.5.2015 registered under Sections 452/506/324/148/149/120-B at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him. He prays for allowing the present petition.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Yadwinder Singh, Police Station Dhanaula, submits that though the petitioner has not joined the investigation but since nothing is to be recovered from him, he is no more required for any further investigation
