The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.313, dated 17.6.2015, registered under Sections 304-B, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Mani Majra, Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that actually the deceased had committed suicide because she was involved with some body else and was pregnant before her marriage and on this ground anticipatory bail was granted to the son of the petitioner.

Learned standing counsel for UT Chandigarh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of

the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
