Case was registered on the allegation that one Sukhdev Singh impersonated as Gurdev Singh and sale deed dated 11.10.1994 was registered in favour of Chhajju Singh. This sale deed was witnessed by Sukhdev Singh-petitioner herein. Same was registered 22 years after death of Gamdoor Singh. Instant FIR was registered. In support of its case, prosecution examined as many as 11 witnesses and produced documentary evidence. In their statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C accused pleaded innocence and claimed that they had been falsely implicated. However, on consideration of all the issues involved, trial court convicted accused for various offences. Petitioner-herein was convicted for the offences under Sections 420/419/465/468/120-B IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year. Accused preferred appeal before Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. Two accused namely, Chhajju Singh and

Krishan Baldev were acquitted and petitioner was convicted for offence under Section 199 IPC only and released on probation. Present revision is directed against the said order. I find no ground to interfere in the revisional jurisdiction. Appellate court has already taken a lenient view and released the petitioner on probation.

Dismissed.
