Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for directing respondent no.4 to decide the complaint dated 28.7.2014 (Annexure P-3) and conduct a fair enquiry and investigation in FIR No.162 dated 21.7.2014 under Sections 354, 323, 427, 380, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuljit Singh, submits that the police has already submitted cancellation

report but the petitioner has shown his dissatisfaction, for which, remedy is available to him.

Without commenting upon the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 to consider and decide the complaint dated 28.7.2014 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.
