JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The two petitioners/accused, namely, Balbir Singh and Nishan Singh are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16 dated 23.04.2015, under Sections 295, 295-A, 298, 380, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Batala.

As per the allegations, two petitioners/accused i.e. Bhai Balbir Singh and Bhai Nishan Singh along with others destroyed three places of worship in Village Seeda, namely, New Shesh Naag, Old Shesh Naag and Baba Madaar. They also pulled out the Flags at the site and committed theft by taking away one Silver Statue of Lord Shivji weighing 2.5 Kgs. along with small Safe box/locker containing lots of money.

It is apparent that learned lower Court had granted interim protection and the pre-arrest bail was eventually dismissed due to the non cooperative attitude of the petitioners.

This Court has also granted interim bail, however, the petitioners still did not cooperate in the investigation.

At this stage, faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
