Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.207 dated 26.06.2009, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Jalandhar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 06.09.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the registration of the case the petitioner was arrested and released on bail. He had been regularly appearing before the trial Court thereafter. However, on 13.06.2013 he could not appear, as in the meantime he was arrested on 31.05.2013 in a case under Section 411 IPC in which he pleaded guilty and was released on 13.02.2014. He then applied for the grant of anticipatory bail, but the same has been declined by Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide order dated 07.08.2014. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings,

once again.

*Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab for
13.11.2014.*

*In the meantime, the petitioner shall surrender
before the trial Court on or before 17.09.2014. In the
event of his doing so, he be admitted to ad-interim bail
to its satisfaction.”*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant
Sub Inspector Tarsem Singh has submitted that in pursuance
to the order dated 06.09.2014, petitioner has surrendered
before the trial Court and has furnished interim bail.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the
petitioner vide order dated 06.09.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
