Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.221 dated 6.8.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 325, 379 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

This Court vide order dated 8.9.2015, while relying upon **CRM-M-7084 of 2015** titled as 'Pardeep Kumar vs. State of Punjab' decided on 7.5.2015 and **CRM-M-16695 of 2015** titled as 'Chandan versus State of Punjab' decided on 21.8.2015, issued notice of motion and granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the

investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Jaswant Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 8.9.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
