Learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition to enable the petitioner to take all the pleas before learned Court below. However, he submits that the petitioner is about 79 years old and is at the fag end of his life, therefore, learned Trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

Learned counsel for the State has no objection to the above prayer. However, on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar of Police Station, Sector 11, Chandigarh, he submits that out of 33

witnesses, 13 have been examined and the next date before learned Trial Court is 2.3.2015.

Disposed of with a direction to the learned Trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within four months from the next date of hearing.
