Learned counsel for the U.T. informs that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the interim order passed.

Learned counsel for the complainant has made a statement to the effect that the matter has been compromised and that the compromise is to be presented before this Court after the terms are finally settled. Since the matter is being compromised and terms are to be finally settled, the liberty of the petitioner can be protected as the parties appear to be in civil litigation also.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to following conditions:

- (i) that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
- (iii) that the petitioner will produce a copy of the compromise after settlement of the terms within a period of three months with the investigation officer or with the Court concerned.
