Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Gurpreet @ Gagandeep in the cross version case under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 & 506 IPC in case FIR No.126 dated 11.06.2007 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 506 IPC registered with Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

The rest of the co-accused in the cross version case were acquitted by the learned trial Court vide order dated 27.09.2010, however, the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender on 1.6.2010 since at that relevant time he had gone to Spain. It is also contended that the rival parties belong to the same village and had entered into a compromise resulting into the acquittal of the accused in the main FIR as well.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Mehar states that pursuant to interim directions passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 10.09.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
