JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 65, dated 29.05.2014 (**Annexure P-1**), for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations, 120 grams of intoxicant powder containing the contraband, the quantity of which is commercial in nature, had been recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Satwinder Singh, states that only five official witnesses are remain to be examined and the case is fixed for 29.10.2015.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and in view of above, the present petition for regular bail is disposed of with a direction to the prosecution to conclude their evidence positively by 30.11.2015, failing which the petitioner would be entitled to file a fresh petition for regular bail.

The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to ensure the presence of all the prosecution witnesses, who are police officials, before the trial Court on the dates fixed to facilitate the conclusion of the prosecution evidence.
