By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.353, dated 02.07.2014, registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Palwal.

The learned counsel contends that the complainant, Jaipal Singh, had earlier filed a criminal complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and Section 420 IPC against the petitioner No.1, which was dismissed by the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate on 02.06.2014 and now again, he has registered the

instant false case against the petitioners. In pursuance of the order dated 04.09.2014, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation but the amount is yet to be recovered.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.09.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
