In compliance of the order dated 06.04.2015 passed by this Court, reply by way of affidavit dated 12.05.2015 filed in the Court today, is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Randeep Singh, Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, submits that untraced/cancellation report has already been presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction. It is clear from order Annexure R-2 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri. He further submits that in view of the cancellation report having been presented to the learned Court, present petition does not survive any further and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
