This order shall dispose of aforementioned two petitions bearing CRM-M No. 30478 of 2014, titled as "Balvir Ram and Others Versus State of Punjab and Another" and CRM-M No. 32650 of 2014, titled as "Hardeep Kumar Versus State of Punjab and Another", as both these petitions have arisen out of the same occurrence.

Both the above mentioned petitions have been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 128, dated 31.08.2011, under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal

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Code and added later on under Sections 325 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station-Phillaur, District Jalandhar and its cross version recorded in the above said FIR on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report from the trial Court has been received in both cases, in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise. It was a personal dispute which has been amicably settled.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR and its cross version stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR and its cross version also stand quashed.
