Petitioner Chaman Lal has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.107 dated 30.08.2014, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case has been got registered by Aman Kumar alleging that after the death of his father, signatures of his father were forged by Chaman Lal, who is worker of Dhamoli Majri Welfare Society and withdrawn an amount of Rs.30,375/- on 26.01.2014 and then deposited it on 21.02.2014. Similarly, he again withdrew the amount so many times by forging the signatures of father of complainant and then deposited the same in the account. The present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He is also required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, I do not find it a fit case, where the petitioner is entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed.
