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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J (ORAL)

Santosh and Anju Devi, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They have placed on record Marriage certificate, Annexure-P3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 28.08.2015, Annexure P-4 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Ashwani Nagra put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4. Respondent No.4, father of petitioner No.2 is also present in Court. He states that he has no objection to the marriage and he wants to arrange a function for their marriage in October

2015. The petitioners also have no objection to this.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.2 to grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. Protection will be given to the petitioner during the function to be held in October. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
