Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 289, dated 29.05.2015 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

This Court, vide order dated 14.09.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that there is compromise between the parties, the petitioner had joined investigation in terms of the order dated 14.09.2015 passed by this Court

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Narender Kumar, also submits that the petitioner had joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Mr. Sanjay Verma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. He has also not controverted the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 14.09.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C
