Prayer in this petition is for registration of FIR against the persons mentioned in Annexure P-4 for committing fraud with public and for embezzling with the public funds.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of Kulwant Singh, DSP, Headquarter, Jind, on behalf of respondents no.1, 2 and 4, wherein it has been mentioned that neither such complaint dated 23.5.2014 (Annexure P-4) has been received in the office of Superintendent of Police, Jind nor at Police Station, Uchana and as per letter dated 7.5.2014 (Annexure P-2) and complaint (Annexure

P-3), it transpires that the matter relates to demolition of shops in the Market Committee, Uchana and thus, the whole matter relates to the Deputy Commissioner, Jind and the local police has no role to play.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already submitted representations dated 28.4.2014 (Annexure P-1) and 12.5.2014 (Annexure P-3) to Deputy Commissioner, Jind, but no action is being taken thereon.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Deputy Commissioner, Jind to look into the representations dated 28.4.2014 (Annexure P-1) and 12.5.2014 (Annexure P-3) and take a decision thereon in accordance with law.
