**SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.**

Petitioners – Satwant Singh and Gurwinder Singh @ Ginda have applied for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in case bearing FIR No. 112 dated 10.11.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 325, 323, 326, 336, 341, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

Prosecution story is that on 8.11.2014 at about 6.00 PM, petitioners alongwith co-accused were armed with deadly weapons and caused injuries to Harpreet Singh [complainant], Saravjit Singh and Jagdeep Singh. Petitioner No.2 Gurwinder Singh alias Ginda allegedly caused injury with gandasi on the left arm of Sarvjit Singh and Petitioner

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No.1-Satwant Singh also gave gandasi blow from reverse side on his belly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the present is a case of version and cross-version. From their side Manpreet Singh had also sustained injuries. Petitioners are ready to join the investigation. So, they be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as also counsel for the complainant submitted that the petitioners were armed with deadly weapons and had caused injuries and they are required for the purpose of investigation. So, there are no grounds for release of the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

Having considered that the petitioners were armed with deadly weapons and had caused injuries and they are required for custodial investigation as also the recovery of weapons used for commission of offence also to be effected, no grounds for releasing the petitioners on anticipatory bail are made out.

The petition stands dismissed.
