1. *Whether Reporters of Local Newspapers may be allowed to see the judgment ?*

Petitioner has filed this petition for issuing directions to official respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there was a dispute regarding land measuring 7 kanal 13 marla. The land was in possession of the petitioner. The injunction suit was filed, in which, temporary stay was refused. The civil dispute is still pending. An FIR was registered at the instance of the petitioner. Now an FIR has been registered against the petitioner regarding the said land. So far as civil dispute is concerned, parties are left to agitate the same before civil Court and seek appropriate relief . This Court is not to interfere in the civil dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that house of

the petitioner was earlier attacked by the private respondents Nos.6 to 15 and that he may be physically harmed. This contention is controverted by the opposite counsel who has stated about the criminal background of the petitioner.

In any case, without going into controversy on merit, a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to look into the grievance of the petitioner and assess threat perception to the petitioner, if any. If it is found that there is threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, then the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa will take necessary steps to protect life and liberty of the petitioner.

A similar grievance of the private respondents Nos.6 to 15 shall also be considered and decided by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa.

With aforesaid directions, the petition stands disposed of.
