ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.07 dated 21.01.2015, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 34 IPC, Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had lodged the FIR but the police had challaned her for murder of her mother. Counsel contends that all the private witnesses have been examined and they have not supported the prosecution version. The counsel has placed on record the list showing the names of the witnesses who remain to be examined.

The State counsel concedes that the private witnesses have been examined and only official witnesses remain to be examined.

The petitioner had been arrested on 29.01.2015. The private witnesses including the witness to the extra judicial confession have not supported the prosecution. The trial will take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
