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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.28 dated 01.07.2015, under Sections 7,13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered with Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, District Gurgaon.

The petitioner is a Inspector, Food and Supplies Department, Government of Haryana.

The allegations are that he had demanded a bribe of Rs.20,000/- for supply of ration items to the complainant/depot holder. A trap was laid by the State Vigilance Department and he was caught red handed on 01.07.2015 accepting the part payment of Rs.10,000/- of the bribe.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 01.07.2015 and the case is now at the stage of recording of evidence of the prosecution. The next date of hearing fixed is 29.10.2015.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer for grant of interim bail in view of the imminent date of delivery of the pregnant wife. To support the said basis, learned Counsel for the petitioner has shown photocopy of OPD Card, which is taken on record.

On examination of the said document, the prayer of the petitioner appears to be reasonable and, therefore, liable to be accepted.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Sehdev, State Vigilance Bureau, is present in the Court and does not refute the contention.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, the prayer for grant of interim bail is justified.

Accordingly, the present petition is partly allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail till 27.10.2015 subject to the furnishing of heavy sureties to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, and also that he shall himself surrender before the concerned Jail Authorities on 28.10.2015 at 2:00 PM.

Disposed of in the above terms.
