Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioners namely Rajni Rampal and Karan Kumar in case FIR No.292 dated 10.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 3/32 of HPIDFE Act, 2014 registered with Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

As per allegations in the FIR the company has sold the flats to the complainant without disclosing that the land upon which the said flats are to be constructed was under a mortgage.

It is contended that the petitioner no.1 is a housewife and the petitioner no.2 is a student and have absolutely no connection with the company with whom the complainant has entered into an agreement to sell

for purchase of the said flats.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Sukhwinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 09th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
