Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.49 dated 05.04.2015, under Section 304-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 10.09.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that initially, brother of the deceased had lodged a report that his sister had accidentally consumed some expired medicine. However, later FIR in question was registered. Now, the parties

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have amicably settled their dispute.

Notice of motion for 20.10.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. ”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Inderjit Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 10.09.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
