JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, who is the widow of Shri Baldev Krishan, has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking a direction to the police authorities to restrain from harassing her at the instance of Gian Chand (respondent No. 5 herein), who is the uncle of deceased-Baldev Krishan.

It is submitted that on the death of Shri Baldev Krishan on 13.08.2002, his property devolved on natural inheritance on the class one legal heirs i.e. widow-petitioner, mother of the deceased and two sons, however, respondent No. 5 wrongly executed the inheritance of the missing son, namely, Parmod Kumar.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of the State has been filed wherein it has been stated that after enquiry, it was found that there was no threat whatsoever life and liberty of the petitioner and the dispute is being civil in nature.

In view of the above, no further action/order is required to be passed in the present case.

Dismissed as infructuous.
