Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.52 dated 01.03.2015, under Section 376-D of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that on 26.02.2015 at about 2:15 P.M. while the prosecutrix was present near Gurudwara Hazara Hazur, then she was taken away by the petitioner and his co-accused. All the accused then committed the offence of rape.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely involved in this case.

In the present case, petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. Petitioner and his co-accused had raped the prosecutrix who is aged about fifteen years.

Keeping in view the seriousness of allegations levelled against the petitioner, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made out.

Dismissed.
