HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.6 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the age of respondent No.2-Farmeena is 22 years, which is apparent from the Ration Card (Annexure P-3), issued in the year 2005, when her age was shown as 12 years. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the petitioners being major have performed the Nikaah in accordance with their personal law. However, respondents No.6 to 11 are not accepting their Nikaah and are adamant to separate them from each

other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 1.9.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon-respondent No.2.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Kapil Aggarwal, Additional A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter but without going into the validity of the Nikaah (marriage), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 1.9.2015 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.6 to 11.
