This order will dispose of two petition, CRM-M-30734-2014 field by Vicky and others for quashing of FIR No.148 dated 07.06.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149, IPC registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar and CRM-M-30743-2014 filed by Shakti and others for quashing of cross case, registered vide rapat

No.26 dated 08.06.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34, IPC registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar, in the aforesaid FIR.

Petitioners Vicky etc. alongwith one Sunny had allegedly constituted an unlawful assembly armed with baseball bats and kirpan and caused injuries on the person of respondent No.2 Shakti and respondent No.3 Mamta.

Before the presentation of challan the matter has been compromised. The statements of the parties except Sunny, a proclaimed offender, have been recorded.

In CRM-M-30743-2014 the cross-version was recorded at the instance of respondent No.2-Sital, on the allegation that Shakti and others had caused injuries on the person of Ravi and Davinder.

Both the parties have now entered into a compromise. Their statements have been recorded. Since Sunny has neither been arrested nor impleaded a party, it will be not appropriate to partly quash an FIR as well as cross-version.

These petitions are disposed of with a direction that investigating officer shall record the supplementary statements of the parties and it will be open to the investigating agency to present cancellation report in the FIR as well as the cross-version. On the basis of the statements of the parties recorded, the Illaqa Magistrate would be entitled to accept the cancellation report in both the cases.
